and IDs as “Newstalk 10-10” (Fair-Good Oct 10 HTS) – *the historic call letters of CFRB which stand for “Canada’s First Rogers Batteryless” are not used in IDs anymore - ed*

**6155 THAILAND BBC** at 1342 with IS and 1345 s/on with Asian music, time pips and announcements in listed Burmese. (Poor Sept 30 HTS)

**6160 CANADA CKZU** Vancouver presumed at 1302 with CBC news, few minutes later heard mention of NHL game between Edmonton and Vancouver the previous night. (Poor Oct 20 HTS)

**6170 NEW ZEALAND RNZI** at 1332 with coverage of Samoan earthquake and tsunami (Good Sept 30 HTS) – *this is a temporary frequency to Oct 24th – 7440 is the B09 frequency - ed*

**6195 SINGAPORE BBC** at 1301 with news leading off with Samoan tsunami (Very poor Sept 30 HTS)

**6348 KOREA Echo of Hope** tentative at 1344, man speaking in probable Korean (Poor with possibly jamming Oct 22 HTS)

**9335 NORTH KOREA Voice of Korea** at 1300 English s/on with “This is Voice of Korea” repeated by man and woman, IS, and national anthem (Fair Oct 22 HTS)

**9625 CANADA CBC North** at 1331 with the end of the news in English then Quebec weather and into “The Current” (Good Oct 20 HTS)

**15735 SWEDEN Radio Sweden** at

1415 in Spanish with a woman conducting an interview (Poor Oct 2 MY)

**9570 CUBA China Radio Int'l** at 1627 with program on economic development. (Good with QRM Oct 3 HTS)

**9585 VATICAN Vatican Radio** at 1641 in Ukrainian, two women with

religious-sounding programming. (Fair Oct 24 HTS)

**7295 MALAYSIA Traxx FM** at 1708-1720, Western pop music from late 50s and 60s (e.g. Peggy Sue by Buddy Holly and a of couple songs by Connie Francis), no announcer noted. (Poor Oct 24 HTS)

**7315 CHINA CRI** at 1713 in English with "News and Reports", reporting on car safety. //7335 good. (Very good Oct 24 HTS)

**7620 CHINA CPBSt Beijing**, with talk 1718 in Chinese to Taiwan. (Weak Oct 24 HTS)

**9335 NORTH KOREA Voice of Korea** at 1701 with IS, woman with ID in Korean, anthem, 1703 into programming. (Good, also good on 11710 Oct 3 HTS)

**9380 THAILAND VOA** at 1724 in Pashto, popular national songs with appreciative crowd noise. (Fair Oct 24 HTS)

**9535 JAPAN NHK World Network** at 1638 in Japanese, classical vocals and romantic ballads. (Exc Oct 24 HTS)

**9830 JORDAN Radio Jordan** presumed the one signing on at 1745 with brief piece of music, then man in Arabic with brief talks, with piano music bridges - possibly news. (Good but strong QRM Oct 3 HTS)

**10000 HAWAII WWVH** at 1732, time announcement in advance and well over WWV. (Very good Oct 3 HTS)

**11510 ARMENIA Voice of Russia** at 1700 switching from French to English

after Moscow bells and then ID "This is Moscow." (Fair Oct 24 HTS)

**11620 INDIA AIR** at 1743 with barely discernible IS prior to 1745 s/on in English. On frequent checks later they got no better than poor. (Very weak Oct 24 HTS)

**11735 ROMANIA Radio Romania Int'l** at 1718, English, man and woman with arts and culture reports, IDs. (Poor through strong QRM Oct 3 HTS) also at 1700 with "Radio Newsreel" (Excellent Oct 12 RG)

**11835 SOUTH AFRICA VOA** at 1723 with sports report and ID (Poor Oct 3 HTS)

**11900 CHINA China Radio Int'l** at 1725, English, talking about economic advancement in rural townships. (Good, //11940 poor Oct 3 HTS)

**11990 KUWAIT Radio Kuwait** at 1759, marching band music, 1800 time pips, ID, local time at English s/on. (Good Oct 3 HTS)

**11995 LIBYA Voice of Africa** at 1720 in French with "La Voix de l'Afrique" ID and talk about the growth of capitalism in Africa (Poor Oct 12 RG)

**12040 RUSSIA Voice of Russia** at 1717 with mailbag program answering a question about flags in the Russian Federation (Good Oct 12 RG)

**13590 GERMANY CVC Voice Africa** at 1758 with a man with talk about his life then a "One Africa with hope" ID (Fair Sep 20 MY)

**15400 ASCENSION BBC** at 1757 with sports report (Fair Oct 3 HTS)

**15580 BOTSWANA VOA** at 1750, English, discussing Honduran political situation. (Very good Oct 3 HTS)

**15610 USA WEWN** at 1705 with "The Doctor Is In" with "A Pilgrimage Minute" at 1709 (Excellent Oct 12 JR)

**15630 GREECE Voice of Greece** at 1700 in Greek with a woman giving the news headlines (Very good Oct 12 JR)

**9970 BELGIUM RTBF** at 1853 in French with middle eastern string music then a woman at 1857 with "Vous écoutez La Vivacite" - local light music network ID (Fair Oct 12 MAC) - *this one is known to relay a number of RTBF networks which are listed in the National Radio section of the WRTH under Belgium - ed*

**11510 ARMENIA Voice of Russia** at 1818 in with a talk that was focused upon history, but couldn't make out topic then ID at 1831 (Poor Oct 3 HTS)

**11735 TANZANIA-ZANZIBAR TBC-Zanzibar** at 1801 with a man with news in English with East African items then world news followed by "This news is coming to you from ...(could have been TBC), Zanzibar." at 1807 and time check and into music (Fair-good Oct 3 HTS)

**11990 KUWAIT Radio Kuwait** at 1800 with time pips, ID, national anthem, sked, then into "Companions to Islam" (Very Good Oct 12 RG)

**15085 IRAN VOIRI** at 1846, woman in French, talk, music bridges. (Good Oct 24 HTS)

**15215 LIBYA Voice of Africa** at 1848 in listed Hausa, nice African hi-life song, announcer frequently mentioning Africa. Gone at 1924 re-check, but see 11995. (Fair Oct 24 HTS)

**15385 USA KJES** (New Mexico) at 1850, Bible readings with children repeating. (Poor Oct 24 HTS)

**17680 CHILE CVC** at 1830 in Spanish with a man and woman with talk mentioning "C-V-C noticias" and numerous mentions of "C-V-C" (Poor-fair, noise and fading Oct 3 HTS)

**18980 USA Family Radio** at 1737, preacher in English then into Russian at 1739 (Very poor Oct 24 HTS)

**21840 PORTUGAL Deutsche Welle** at 1740, just a trace of talk and music, listed as French. (Poor through local noise Oct 24 HTS)

### **1900 - 1959**

**6030 CANADA CFVP** (Calgary) at 1940, country music, IDs as "Classic Country AM 10-60". Frequency carries audio of station CKMX. (Fair to good Oct 24 HTS)

**6160 CANADA CKZU Vancouver** at 1955 with "Quirks and Quarks" (Fair Oct 3 HTS)

**11660 FRANCE Radio Netherlands** at 1902 with news then "The State We're In" at 1906 (Fair Oct 3 HTS) also at 1930 with news then "Curious Orange" at 1935 (Weak and noisy Oct 12 MAC) also at 1905 in English, news. (Fair Oct 24 HTS) – *for the B09 season this will be replaced by 11655 via Madagascar - ed*

**11795 ENGLAND Deutsche Welle** at 1911 with English news (Very good Oct 3 HTS)

**11840 GERMANY Family Radio** at 1932 in French, at 1945 had an English language Bible reading "in slow English" and it was agonizingly slow! (Poor with buzz on frequency Oct 24 HTS)

**11880 AUSTRALIA Radio Australia** at 1930 in English with news. (Fair-good Oct 24 HTS)

**11910 NORTH KOREA Voice of Korea** at 1927 in English with ID, item on factory production of medicines. Directed to S. Africa according to 2009 Passport. (Fair Oct 24 HTS)

**11990 KUWAIT Radio Kuwait** at 1927 with pop music then a feature on the origins of the call to prayer at 1930 (Good Oct 14 MY)

**11995 LIBYA Voice of Africa** at 1924 in Hausa, similar programming as on 15215 earlier. Many mentions of Africa. (Poor Oct 24 HTS)

**12085 SYRIA Radio Damascus** at 1910 in French, woman with probable news, 1913 Arabic music. Poor-fair, low modulation. Is sked to 2000, but

at 1934 re-check they were off. (Oct 24 HTS)

**13765 VATICAN Vatican Radio** at 1900 in Italian with ID and news (Very Good Oct 12 RG)

**15400 ASCENSION ISLAND BBC** at 1909 with news with a report on Guinea (Good Oct 12 RG)

**15630 GREECE Voice of Greece** at 1956 in Greek with local music then OC at 1959 and a man with apparent news at 2000 (Poor Sep 30 MY)

### 2000 - 2059

**9385 USA WWRB** (Tennessee) at 2022 in English, preaching about Old Testament Hezekiah. (Fair Oct 24 HTS)

**9580 GABON Africa Number One** at 2007, French, man with news, 2008 "Africa Numero Un" ID. (Fair Oct 24 HTS)

**9610 GERMANY Family Radio** at 2027 in English, program "Beyond Intelligent Design", 2029 ID. (Fair Oct 24 HTS)

**11610 FRANCE Radio Netherlands** at 2045- 2055 with "Network Europe" (Excellent Oct 19 LF) – *for B09 this should be replaced by 11655 via Madagascar - ed*

**11795 PORTUGAL Deutsche Welle** at 2030 with a man and woman hosting a special all-music edition of "Cool" // 11865 (Weak Oct 13 MAC) – *for B09 this frequency should be replaced by 9690 via the United Kingdom - ed*

**11810 ASCENSION ISLAND BBC** at 2043, English, "Newshour" with panel discussing lifestyles in the developing world. (Poor-fair Oct 24 HTS)

**11865 UNITED KINGDOM Deutsche Welle** at 2030 // 11795 with Margot Forbes and Rita Oliver hosting "In Box" mailbag program (Good Oct 3 MAC) – *for B09 this frequency should be replaced by 9735 via Kigali, Rwanda, and 13780 via Sri Lanka - ed*

**13640 ALBANIA Radio Tirana** at 2002 beginning English, giving sked, greeting to listeners. (Poor ct 24 HTS)

**15110 SPAIN REE** at 2005 in Spanish with European soccer report (Good Sep 30 MY)

**15120 NIGERIA Voice of Nigeria** at 2003 with news then "This is African Hour coming to you from Voice of Nigeria." at 2009 (Good but low modulation Oct 3 HTS)

### 2100 - 2159

**9735 PORTUGAL Deutsche Welle** at 2120 with "Newslink" with a report by Raphael Kapuski from Poland on bringing those behind martial law in the 80's to justice (Very Good Oct 19 MAC) – *this will be replaced by 7280 also via Sines, Portugal for B09 - ed*

**9830 TURKEY Voice of Turkey** at 2159 with IS, ID and signing on at 2200 in English. (Poor Sept 28 HTS)

**11865 RWANDA Deutsche Welle** at 2130 // 15205 with Deborah Friedman hosting "Hits in Germany" featuring rock duets (Very Good Oct 5 MAC) – *for B09 this frequency should be*

*replaced by 11690, also via Rwanda, which can often be hampered by UTE QRM - ed*

**11955 AUSTRIA AWR** at 2100-2105 with ID and religious stuff (Excellent Oct 19 LF)

**11990 KUWAIT Radio Kuwait** at 2030 with pop music then a woman with ID, TC, and news in brief at 2050 then more music to 2058 then a woman with closing announcements then national anthem then time pips at 2100 and into Arabic with a "Huna Al Kuwait" ID, brief national anthem and off (Very Good Oct 12 MAC)

**15205 RWANDA Deutsche Welle** at 2130 with Deborah Friedman's "Hits in Germany" featuring great tunes and music-related literature from a Munich book fair (Very Good Oct 12 MAC) – *the B09 frequency replacing this should be 9545 and 13780 both via Sri Lanka – ed*

### **2200 - 2259**

**9665 PRIDNESTROVIE Radio PMR** on suddenly at 2215 with opening announcements and into a long talk that dealt with a Moldovan power station, which I believe the announcer said had been destroyed sometime in the past. (Poor Sept 28 HTS)
